- 1 AN ACT Relating to game fish mitigation; adding new sections to
- 2 chapter 43.131 RCW; and adding a new chapter to Title 77 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature declares that the public
- 5 and private propagation, production, protection, and enhancement of
- 6 fish is in the public interest.
- 7 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. Unless the context clearly requires
- 8 otherwise, the definitions in this section apply throughout this
- 9 chapter.
- 10 (1) "Department" means the Washington department of wildlife.
- 11 (2) "Contract" means an agreement setting at a minimum, price,
- 12 quantity of fish to be delivered, time of delivery, and fish health
- 13 requirements.

- 1 (3) "Fish health requirements" means those site specific fish
- 2 health and genetic requirements actually used by the department of
- 3 wildlife in fish stocking.
- 4 (4) "Aquatic farmer" means a private sector person who commercially
- 5 farms and manages private sector cultured aquatic products on the
- 6 person's own land or on land in which the person has a present right of
- 7 possession.
- 8 (5) "Person" means a natural person, corporation, trust, or other
- 9 legal entity.
- 10 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** If the department requires, pursuant to
- 11 its authority relative to environmental permits or licenses, that
- 12 resident hatchery game fish be stocked by the permittee or licensee for
- 13 mitigation of environmental damage, the department shall specify the
- 14 pounds or numbers, species, stock, and/or race of resident game fish
- 15 that are to be provided. The department shall offer the permittee or
- 16 licensee the option of purchasing under contract from aquatic farmers
- 17 in Washington, those game fish, unless the fish specified by the
- 18 department are not available from Washington growers.
- 19 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** Any agency of state or federal
- 20 government, political subdivision of the state, private or public
- 21 utility company, corporation, or sports group, or any purchaser of fish
- 22 under section 3 of this act may purchase resident game fish from an
- 23 aquatic farmer for stocking purposes if permit requirements of this
- 24 title and the department have been met.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 5. A new section is added to chapter 43.131 RCW
- 26 to read as follows:

- 1 The game fish mitigation program created in sections 1 through 4 of
- 2 this act shall be terminated on June 30, 1994, as provided in section
- 3 6 of this act.
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 6.** A new section is added to chapter 43.131 RCW
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 The following acts, or parts of acts, as now existing or hereafter
- 7 amended, are each repealed, effective June 30, 1995:
- 8 (1) RCW 77.--.-- and 1991 c ... s ... (section 1 of this act);
- 9 (2) RCW 77.--.-- and 1991 c ... s ... (section 2 of this act);
- 10 (3) RCW 77.--.-- and 1991 c ... s ... (section 3 of this act); and
- 11 (4) RCW 77.--.-- and 1991 c ... s ... (section 4 of this act).
- 12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 7.** Sections 1 through 4 of this act shall
- 13 constitute a new chapter in Title 77 RCW.
