- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 4.44 RCW
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 When setting civil cases for trial, unless otherwise provided by
- 8 statute, upon motion of a party, the court may give priority to cases
- 9 in which a party is frail and over seventy years of age or is afflicted
- 10 with a terminal illness.
