By House Committee on Appropriations (originally sponsored by Representatives May and Locke).

Read first time March 11, 1991.

1 AN ACT Relating to refunding contributions to the judicial
2 retirement system; adding a new section to chapter 2.10 RCW; adding a
3 new section to chapter 2.12 RCW; and creating a new section.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 2.10 RCW
6 to read as follows:

7 If a judge who was a member of this system left the system before
8 July 1, 1988, and neither the judge nor the judge's surviving spouse:
9 (1) Was eligible at that time to receive a benefit under this chapter;
10 or (2) has received an amount under a sundry claims appropriation from
11 the state legislature intended as a refund of the judge's contributions
12 paid under RCW 2.10.090(1); then the judge or the judge's surviving
13 spouse may apply to the department for and receive a refund of such
14 contributions.

1 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 2.12 RCW
2 to read as follows:

3 If a judge who was a member of this system left the system before
4 July 1, 1988, and neither the judge nor the judge's surviving spouse:
5 (1) Was eligible at that time to receive a benefit under this chapter;
6 or (2) has received an amount under a sundry claims appropriation from
7 the state legislature intended as a refund of the judge's contributions
8 paid under RCW 2.12.060; then the judge or the judge's surviving spouse
9 may apply to the department for and receive a refund of such
10 contributions.

11 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** If by June 30, 1991, the omnibus
12 operating budget appropriations act for the 1991-93 biennium does not
13 provide specific funding for this act, referencing this act by bill
14 number, this act is null and void.
