(2) The city or town may charge a licensing or operating fee, but the fee charged a state licensed massage practitioner shall not exceed the licensing or operating fee imposed on similar health care providers, such as physical therapists or occupational therapists, operating within the same city or town. 1 (3) A state licensed massage practitioner is not subject to 2 additional licensing requirements not currently imposed on similar 3 health care providers, such as physical therapists or occupational 4 therapists.

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 35A.11 RCW 6 to read as follows:

7 (1) A state licensed massage practitioner seeking a city license to
8 operate a massage business must provide verification of his or her
9 state massage license as provided for in RCW 18.108.030.

10 (2) The city may charge a licensing or operating fee, but the fee 11 charged a state licensed massage practitioner shall not exceed the 12 licensing or operating fee imposed on similar health care providers, 13 such as physical therapists or occupational therapists, operating 14 within the same city.

15 (3) A state licensed massage practitioner is not subject to 16 additional licensing requirements not currently imposed on similar 17 health care providers, such as physical therapists or occupational 18 therapists.

to read as follows:

(1) A state licensed massage practitioner seeking a county license
to operate a massage business must provide verification of his or her
state massage license as provided for in RCW 18.108.030.

(2) The county may charge a licensing or operating fee, but the fee charged a state licensed massage practitioner shall not exceed the licensing or operating fee imposed on similar health care providers, such as physical therapists or occupational therapists, operating within the same county.
