- 1 AN ACT Relating to assault of wildlife agents and other law
- 2 enforcement officers; and adding a new section to chapter 77.16 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 77.16 RCW
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) The director shall revoke all licenses and privileges extended
- 7 under Title 77 RCW of a person convicted of assault on a state wildlife
- 8 agent or other law enforcement officer provided that:
- 9 (a) The wildlife agent or other law enforcement officer was on duty
- 10 at the time of the assault; and
- 11 (b) The wildlife agent or other law enforcement officer was
- 12 enforcing the provisions of Title 77 RCW.
- 13 (2) For the purposes of this section, the definition of assault
- 14 includes:
- (a) RCW 9A.32.030; murder in the first degree;

- 1 (b) RCW 9A.32.050; murder in the second degree;
- 2 (c) RCW 9A.32.060; manslaughter in the first degree;
- 3 (d) RCW 9A.32.070; manslaughter in the second degree;
- 4 (e) RCW 9A.36.011; assault in the first degree;
- (f) RCW 9A.36.021; assault in the second degree; and 5
- 6 (g) RCW 9A.36.031; assault in the third degree.
- 7 (3) For the purposes of this section, a conviction includes:
- (a) A determination of guilt by the court; 8
- 9 (b) The entering of a guilty plea to the charge or charges by the 10 accused;
- (c) A forfeiture of bail or a vacation of bail posted to the court; 11 12 or
- (d) The imposition of a deferred or suspended sentence by the 13 14 court.
- 15 (4) No license described under Title 77 RCW shall be reissued to a person violating this section for a minimum of ten years, at that time 16 a person may petition the director of wildlife for a reinstatement of 17 his or her license or licenses. The ten-year period shall be tolled 18 19 during any time the convicted person is incarcerated in any state or 20 local correctional or penal institution, in community supervision, or home detention for an offense under this section. Upon review by the 21
- director, and if all provisions of the court that imposed sentencing
- have been completed, the director may reinstate in whole or in part the 23
- licenses and privileges under Title 77 RCW. 24
