7 A person required to pay an impact fee for system improvements 8 pursuant to RCW 82.02.050 through 82.02.090 shall not be required to 9 pay a fee pursuant to RCW 43.21C.060 for those same system 10 improvements.

11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 82.02 RCW 12 to read as follows:

p. 1 of 2

1 A person required to pay a fee pursuant to RCW 43.21C.060 for 2 system improvements shall not be required to pay an impact fee under 3 RCW 82.02.050 through 82.02.090 for those same system improvements.
