1 AN ACT Relating to a state tartan; and adding a new section to 2 chapter 1.20 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 1.20 RCW 5 to read as follows:

6 The Washington state tartan is hereby designated. The tartan shall 7 have a pattern of colors, called a sett, that is made up of a green 8 background with stripes of blue, white, yellow, red, and black. The 9 secretary of state shall register the tartan with the Scottish Tartan 10 Society, Comrie, Perthshire, Scotland.
