- 1 AN ACT Relating to shipments of wine; adding new sections to
- 2 chapter 66.12 RCW; and prescribing penalties.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** Notwithstanding any other provision of
- 5 Title 66 RCW, the holder of a license to manufacture wine in a state
- 6 which affords holders of a Washington license issued under RCW
- 7 66.24.170 an equal reciprocal shipping privilege, may ship for personal
- 8 use and not for resale not more than two cases of wine of its own
- 9 manufacture per year, with each case containing not more than nine
- 10 liters, to any state resident twenty-one years of age or older. Out-
- 11 of-state wine manufacturers that are authorized to ship wine pursuant
- 12 to sections 1 through 4 of this act shall first obtain a license from
- 13 the Washington state liquor control board under procedures prescribed
- 14 by rule of the board, before shipping wine into Washington. Delivery

- 1 of a shipment under this section shall not be deemed to constitute a
- 2 sale in this state.
- 3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** The shipping container of any wine sent
- 4 into or out of this state under section 1 of this act shall be clearly
- 5 labeled to indicate that the package cannot be delivered to a person
- 6 under twenty-one years of age or to an intoxicated person.
- 7 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** Pickup, delivery, or acceptance of any
- 8 container of wine, by a person, that is shipped into this state to a
- 9 person from a person who is not licensed as provided in section 1 of
- 10 this act, shall constitute a civil violation and be subject to the
- 11 penalties imposed by chapter 66.44 RCW.
- 12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** A license issued under section 1 of this
- 13 act to a wine manufacturer, shipper, or person located outside this
- 14 state who, within this state, advertises for or solicits consumers to
- 15 engage in interstate reciprocal wine shipment under sections 1 through
- 16 4 of this act shall be revoked.
- 17 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 5.** Sections 1 through 4 of this act are
- 18 each added to chapter 66.12 RCW.
