1            AN ACT Relating to the maintenance and investment of assets by  
2 reciprocal exchanges; and adding a new section to chapter 48.10 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4            NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 48.10 RCW  
5 to read as follows:

6            A reciprocal insurer may purchase, sell, mortgage, encumber, lease,  
7 or otherwise affect the title to real property for the purposes and  
8 objects of the reciprocal insurer. All deeds, notes, mortgages, or  
9 other documents relating to the real property may be executed in the  
10 name of the reciprocal insurer by its attorney.
