- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 3 Sec. 1. RCW 10.82.030 and 1983 c 276 s 2 are each amended to read
- 4 as follows:
- 5 If any person ordered into custody until the fine and costs
- 6 adjudged against him be paid shall not, within five days, pay, or cause
- 7 the payment of the same to be made, the clerk of the court shall issue
- 8 a warrant to the sheriff commanding him to imprison such defendant in
- 9 the county jail until the amount of such fine and costs owing are paid.
- 10 Execution may at any time issue against the property of the defendant
- 11 for that portion of such fine and costs not reduced by the application
- 12 of this section. The amount of such fine and costs owing shall be the
- 13 whole of such fine and costs reduced by the amount of any portion
- 14 thereof paid, and ((thirty-five dollars)) an amount established by the

- 1 county legislative authority for every day the defendant performs labor
- 2 as provided in RCW 10.82.040, and ((twenty-five dollars)) a lesser
- 3 <u>amount established by the county legislative authority</u> for every day
- 4 the defendant does not perform such labor while imprisoned.
