1 AN ACT Relating to foster family home licenses; amending RCW
2 74.15.110; and repealing RCW 26.44.070.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 74.15.110 and 1967 c 172 s 11 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 If a licensee desires to apply for a renewal of its license, a
7 request for a renewal shall be filed ninety days prior to the
8 expiration date of the license except that a request for renewal of a
9 foster family home license shall be filed prior to the expiration of
10 the license. If the department has failed to act at the time of the
11 expiration date of the license, the license shall continue in effect
12 until such time as the department shall act.
