- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 79.72.080 and 1977 ex.s. c 161 s 8 are each amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 The following rivers of the state of Washington are hereby
- 7 designated as being in the scenic river system of the state of
- 8 Washington:
- 9 (1) The Skykomish river from the junction of the north and south
- 10 forks of the Skykomish river:
- 11 (a) Downstream approximately fourteen miles to its junction with
- 12 the Sultan river;
- 13 (b) Upstream approximately twenty miles on the south fork to the
- 14 junction of the Tye and Foss rivers;

- 1 (c) Upstream approximately eleven miles on the north fork to its
- 2 junction with Bear creek;
- 3 (2) The Beckler river from its junction with the south fork of the
- 4 Skykomish river upstream approximately eight miles to its junction with
- 5 Rapid river; ((and))
- 6 (3) The Tye river from its junction with the south fork of the
- 7 Skykomish river upstream approximately fourteen miles to Tye Lake; and
- 8 (4) The Little Spokane river from the upstream boundary of the
- 9 state park boat put-in site near Rutter parkway and downstream to its
- 10 confluence with the Spokane river.
- 11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** The sum of thirty thousand dollars, or
- 12 as much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for the biennium
- 13 ending June 30, 1993, from the general fund to the parks and recreation
- 14 commission for the purpose of offsetting the costs of: A management
- 15 assessment plan, an inventory of river resources, preparation of maps,
- 16 facilitation of public forums and task forces, and the production of
- 17 interim and final river management reports to the legislature.
