1            AN ACT Relating to the budget stabilization account; making an  
2 appropriation; and declaring an emergency.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4            NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 1.**            State revenues have declined below  
5 previous projections. Therefore, the sum of one hundred sixty million  
6 dollars from the budget stabilization account is appropriated to the  
7 general fund for the purpose of RCW 43.88.535(1)(a).

8            NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 2.**            This act is necessary for the immediate  
9 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the  
10 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take  
11 effect immediately.
