Brief Description: Allowing school bus drivers to report drivers who fail to stop.

HB 1174-S.E - DIGEST

(AS OF HOUSE 2ND READING 3/15/91)

Allows a school bus driver who observes a violation of RCW 46.61.370 to prepare a written report and deliver the report to a law enforcement official within seventy-two hours of the violation.

Authorizes law enforcement officials to commence an investigation within ten working days.

Requires a review of the current use of aides on special education buses.
