HB 1343-S - DIGEST

(DIGEST OF PROPOSED 1ST SUBSTITUTE)

Authorizes the information to be provided to a person named as a victim of a charged sexual offense under chapter 9A.44 RCW when the alleged offender was subjected to mandatory testing pursuant to RCW 70.24.340.

Establishes procedures for testing, for confidentiality, and for counseling.

Directs the board to specify a schedule for testing at sufficient intervals to detect HIV infection.
