HB 1464-S - DIGEST

(AS OF HOUSE 2ND READING 1/27/92)

Designates the practices which will be deemed to be unlawful in industrial insurance cases.

Provides that the violation of any provision shall be a civil offense with a penalty of up to one thousand dollars.

Clarifies that the penalties are collected for the benefit of the worker.
