Brief Description: Authorizing the replacement of school buses.

HB 1880-S.E - DIGEST

(AS OF HOUSE 2ND READING 3/20/91)

Directs the superintendent to adopt rules to implement a school bus fleet replacement program designed to maintain a state-wide fleet that meets contemporary standards for school bus design and manufacture.

Authorizes payment to school districts for the purpose of liquidating indebtedness for the purchase of buses prior to the effective date of the act.

Takes effect September 1, 1992.

Provides that the act shall be null and void if appropriations are not approved.
