Brief Description: Authorizing infant mortality reviews.

HB 2571-S - DIGEST

(AS OF HOUSE 2ND READING 2/13/92)

Prescribes that all medical records maintained by a local health department for purposes of an infant mortality review are confidential insofar as the identity of an individual infant and his or her natural or adoptive parents are concerned.

Does not prevent a local health department from publishing statistical compilations and reports.
