Brief Description: Requiring good cause to terminate employment close to pension or health benefit qualification.

HB 2787 - DIGEST

Provides that an employer may not terminate an employee within one year of an employee vesting for a pension or benefits, or terminate an employee within sixty days before the employee qualifies for health benefits, without good cause.

Authorizes an action in superior court for any violations.
