3 On page 3, after line 20, insert a new section as follows:

4 "Sec. 7. RCW 36.28.010 and 1965 c 92 s 1 are each amended to  
5 read as follows:

6 The sheriff is the chief (~~(executive))~~ law enforcement officer  
7 and conservator of the peace of the county. In the execution of  
8 his office, he and his deputies:

9 (1) Shall arrest and commit to prison all persons who break  
10 the peace, or attempt to break it, and all persons guilty of public  
11 offenses;

12 (2) Shall defend the county against those who, by riot or  
13 otherwise, endanger the public peace or safety;

14 (3) Shall execute the process and orders of the courts of  
15 justice or judicial officers, when delivered for that purpose,  
16 according to law;

17 (4) Shall execute all warrants delivered for that purpose by  
18 other public officers, according to the provisions of particular  
19 statutes;

20 (5) Shall attend the sessions of the courts of record held  
21 within the county, and obey their lawful orders or directions;

22 (6) Shall keep and preserve the peace in their respective  
23 counties, and quiet and suppress all affrays, riots, unlawful  
24 assemblies and insurrections, for which purpose, and for the  
25 service of process in civil or criminal cases, and in apprehending  
26 or securing any person for felony or breach of the peace, they may  
27 call to their aid such persons, or power of their county as they  
28 may deem necessary."

29 Renumber the following sections consecutively and correct internal  
30 references accordingly.
