6 everything through "fees." on line 7 and insert "The governing
7 board of an institution of higher education as defined in RCW
8 28B.10.016 may impose either a voluntary or a mandatory
9 transportation fee on employees and on students at the institution.
10 The transportation fee shall be used solely to fund transportation
11 demand management programs that reduce the demand for campus and
12 neighborhood parking, and promote alternatives to single-occupant
13 vehicle driving. If the board charges a mandatory transportation
14 fee to students, it shall charge a mandatory transportation fee to
15 employees. The transportation fee for employees may exceed, but
16 shall not be lower than the transportation fee charged to students.
17 The transportation fee for employees may be deducted from the
18 employees' paychecks. The transportation fee for students may be
19 imposed annually, or each academic term. For students, the
20 transportation fee shall not exceed ten percent of the tuition and
21 services and activities fees rate for resident undergraduate
22 students. The board may make a limited number of exceptions to the
23 fee based on a policy adopted by the board."

EFFECT: At institutions of higher education, fees for transportation demand management programs, if adopted, will be charged to employees as well as to students. The fee may be voluntary or mandatory. The fee for employees will equal or exceed the fee for students, and may be deducted from the employees' paychecks. The fee for students may be charged annually or by academic term, and will not exceed 10% of the tuition and fee rate for resident undergraduate students. The board may make exceptions to the fee based on board policy.
