2 By Committee on Appropriations

3 On page 1, after line 19, insert:

4 "(3) The legislature finds that unemployed workers and
5 Washington's economically distressed communities can benefit from
6 opportunities for employment through labor intensive restoration
7 projects.

8 (4) The legislature recognizes that stewardship activities on
9 state-owned lands is a responsible investment consistent with the
10 provisions of this act. It is the intent of the legislature that
11 stewardship activities funded under this chapter provide labor
12 intensive employment.

13 (5) Employment under this chapter is not intended to displace
14 or partially displace currently employed workers, including but not
15 limited to, state employees and service employees under existing
16 contracts."

17 Renumber remaining sections consecutively and correct internal
18 references accordingly.

EFFECT: Adds intent language stating that: economically distressed communities can benefit from labor intensive restoration projects; that stewardship activities receiving environmental restoration funds are labor intensive; and that new restoration jobs do not eliminate existing jobs.
