  10 not adopt a rule the violation of which subjects a person to a penalty
  11 or administrative sanction; that establishes, alters, or revokes a
  12 qualification or standard for the issuance, suspension, or revocation
  13 of a license to pursue a commercial activity, trade, or profession; or
  14 that establishes, alters, or revokes a mandatory standard for a product
- 15 or material that must be met before distribution or sale, unless:
- 16 (a) The rule is needed;
- 17 (b) The likely benefits of the rule are greater than its likely 18 costs;
- 19 (c) There are no alternatives to the rule that would be as 20 effective but less burdensome on those required to comply;
- 21 (d) Any fee imposed is reasonable and related to the cost of 22 administration;
- (e) The rule is clearly and simply stated, so that it can be understood by persons required to comply;
- 25 (f) The rule does not conflict with, overlap, or duplicate any 26 other provision of federal, state, or local law;
- (g) The rule does not, without express statutory authority to do so, differ from any provision of federal law regulating the same activity or subject matter; and
- 30 (h) The rule does not differ in its application to public and 31 private entities.
- 32 (2) Upon adoption of any rule meeting the criteria in subsection
- 33 (1) of this section, an agency shall have a plan to evaluate whether
- 34 the rule achieves the purpose for which it was adopted."
