On page 44, beginning on line 33, after "ARBITRATION." 9 strike all of subsection (1) and insert "(1) (a) (i) If a 10 11 collective bargaining agreement between an exclusive bargaining 12 representative and an employer has expired; or (ii) if there is no agreement between an exclusive bargaining representative and 13 14 an employer and an impasse has occurred; and (iii) the exclusive 15 bargaining representative and the employer have participated, in 16 good faith, in mediation for a reasonable time; or (b) if the legislature rejects or fails to act on the submission of a 17 18 request for funding a collective bargaining agreement as provided in section 302 (3) of this act, the dispute may be submitted for 19 20 final and binding arbitration of the dispute as provided in this section." 21

<u>EFFECT:</u> Eliminates the section authorizing strikes by public employees and establishes when binding arbitration occurs.
