6 a mandatory condition of any term of community supervision, the court
7 shall order the juvenile to refrain from committing new offenses."

8 On page 124, line 5 of the amendment, after "appropriate" insert ".
9 If the court finds that the juvenile has violated the terms of a
10 community supervision order by committing a new offense, the court
11 shall impose thirty days' confinement as a penalty for the violation.
12 This term of confinement shall be in addition to any term of
13 confinement imposed as a disposition for the new offense"

14 On page 138, line 26 of the amendment, after "offenses." insert "As
15 a mandatory condition of any term of community supervision, the court
16 shall order the juvenile to refrain from committing new offenses."

17 On page 163, line 21 of the amendment, after "training;" insert
18 "and"

19 On page 163, line 23 of the amendment, after "address" strike ";
20 and (e)" and insert "((~~i~~ and (~~e~~))). As a mandatory condition of any
21 term of parole, the secretary shall require the juvenile to"

22 On page 164, line 1 of the amendment, after "supervision;" strike
23 "and" and insert "((and))"

24 On page 164, line 8 of the amendment, after "9.94A.030" insert "i
25 and (f) if the secretary determines that the juvenile has violated
26 parole by committing a new offense, the secretary shall order the
27 imposition of thirty days' confinement as a penalty for the violation.
28 This period of confinement shall be in addition to any confinement
29 imposed as a disposition for the new offense"

1 EFFECT: Refraining from committing new offenses is a mandatory
2 condition of community supervision and parole. Juveniles who violate
3 parole or community supervision by committing new offenses shall
4 receive thirty days' confinement as a penalty for the violation. This
5 confinement shall be in addition to any confinement imposed as a
6 disposition for the new offense.
