Expenditures from the account may be used only for appropriations to the department of health for the purposes of 19 20 tobacco use prevention and cessation programs. One-half of this money shall be used for programs that include advertising that uses 21 22 diverse media types, print, radio, television, posters, and strives 23 to reach all high-risk groups across the state and in local 24 communities. The media campaign will educate the public on the health dangers of smoking. One-half of this money shall be used 25 26 for cessation and shall be allocated to those programs that 27 directly aid the individual in the pursuit of overcoming tobacco addiction." 28
