(3) For local citizens to participate in coordinated planning ofcommunity efforts.

17 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. Unless the context clearly requires 18 otherwise, as used in this chapter, "lifelong learning and community 19 involvement in education" means coordinated efforts in communities to 20 provide education to citizens of all ages in a variety of settings 21 using, to the extent possible, shared funding, sites, and staffing.

22 NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. (1) In carrying out his or her duties under 23 subsection (2) of this section, the superintendent of public instruction shall consult with the family policy council, the state 24 board of education, the state board for community and technical 25 26 colleges, the higher education coordinating board, the department of labor and industries, the state library, and other groups, including 27 business and labor, that provide lifelong learning and community 28 involvement in education services. 29

30 (2) The superintendent of public instruction shall:

31 (a) Provide assistance to local communities wishing to coordinate 32 services for lifelong learning and community involvement in education; 33 (b) Encourage local communities to coordinate program and facility 34 resources;

(c) Identify statutory and regulatory provisions impeding local
