7 "<u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 82.04 RCW 8 to read as follows:

(1) "Agricultural product" means any product of plant cultivation 9 or animal husbandry including, but not limited to: A product of 10 grain cultivation, vermiculture, viticulture, or 11 horticulture, 12 aquaculture as defined in RCW 15.85.020; plantation Christmas trees; 13 turf; or any animal including but not limited to an animal that is a private sector cultured aquatic product as defined in RCW 15.85.020, or 14 15 a bird, or insect, or the substances obtained from such an animal. 16 "Agricultural product" does not include animals intended to be pets.

17 (2) "Farmer" means any person engaged in the business of growing or producing, upon the person's own lands or upon the lands in which the 18 person has a present right of possession, any agricultural product 19 20 whatsoever for sale. "Farmer" does not include a person using such products as ingredients in a manufacturing process, or a person growing 21 22 or producing such products for the person's own consumption. "Farmer" 23 does not include a person selling any animal or substance obtained therefrom in connection with the person's business of operating a 24 25 stockyard or a slaughter or packing house. "Farmer" does not include any person in respect to the business of taking, cultivating, or 26 27 raising timber. "Farmer" does not include any association of persons whatever, whether mutual, cooperative, or otherwise, engaging in any 28 29 business activity with respect to which tax liability is imposed under 30 the provisions of this chapter.

31 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 82.08 RCW 32 to read as follows:

33 The tax levied by RCW 82.08.020 shall not apply to sales of:

34 (1) Feed, seed, seedlings, fertilizer, and spray materials to35 persons who participate in the federal conservation reserve program or

1 its successor administered by the United States department of 2 agriculture with respect to land enrolled in that program, or to 3 farmers for the purpose of producing for sale any agricultural product. 4 (2) Chemical sprays or washes to persons for the purpose of post 5 harvest treatment of fruit for the prevention of scald, fungus, mold, 6 or decay.

7 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 82.12 RCW 8 to read as follows:

9 The provisions of this chapter shall not apply in respect to the 10 use of:

(1) Feed, seed, seedlings, fertilizer, and spray materials by 11 12 persons who participate in the federal conservation reserve program or its successor administered by the United States department of 13 14 agriculture with respect to land enrolled in that program, or by 15 farmers for the purpose of producing for sale any agricultural product. (2) Chemical sprays or washes by persons for the purpose of post 16 17 harvest treatment of fruit for the prevention of scald, fungus, mold, 18 or decay.

19 **Sec. 4.** RCW 82.04.050 and 1988 c 253 s 1 are each amended to read 20 as follows:

(1) "Sale at retail" or "retail sale" means every sale of tangible 21 22 personal property (including articles produced, fabricated, or 23 imprinted) to all persons irrespective of the nature of their business 24 and including, among others, without limiting the scope hereof, persons 25 who install, repair, clean, alter, improve, construct, or decorate real or personal property of or for consumers other than a sale to a person 26 27 who (a) purchases for the purpose of resale as tangible personal 28 property in the regular course of business without intervening use by 29 such person, or (b) installs, repairs, cleans, alters, imprints, improves, constructs, or decorates real or personal property of or for 30 31 consumers, if such tangible personal property becomes an ingredient or 32 component of such real or personal property without intervening use by 33 such person, or (c) purchases for the purpose of consuming the property purchased in producing for sale a new article of tangible personal 34 35 property or substance, of which such property becomes an ingredient or component or is a chemical used in processing, when the primary purpose 36 37 of such chemical is to create a chemical reaction directly through

contact with an ingredient of a new article being produced for sale, or 1 2 (d) purchases for the purpose of consuming the property purchased in producing ferrosilicon which is subsequently used in producing 3 4 magnesium for sale, if the primary purpose of such property is to 5 create a chemical reaction directly through contact with an ingredient of ferrosilicon, or (e) purchases for the purpose of providing the 6 7 property to consumers as part of competitive telephone service, as 8 defined in RCW 82.04.065. The term shall include every sale of 9 tangible personal property which is used or consumed or to be used or 10 consumed in the performance of any activity classified as a "sale at retail or "retail sale" even though such property is resold or 11 utilized as provided in (a), (b), (c), (d), or (e) above following such 12 13 use. The term also means every sale of tangible personal property to persons engaged in any business which is taxable under RCW 82.04.280, 14 15 subsections (2) and (7) and RCW 82.04.290.

(2) The term "sale at retail" or "retail sale" shall include the 16 17 sale of or charge made for tangible personal property consumed and/or 18 for labor and services rendered in respect to the following: (a) The 19 installing, repairing, cleaning, altering, imprinting, or improving of 20 tangible personal property of or for consumers, including charges made for the mere use of facilities in respect thereto, but excluding 21 22 charges made for the use of coin operated laundry facilities when such 23 facilities are situated in an apartment house, hotel, motel, rooming 24 house, trailer camp or tourist camp for the exclusive use of the 25 tenants thereof, and also excluding sales of laundry service to members 26 by nonprofit associations composed exclusively of nonprofit hospitals, 27 and excluding services rendered in respect to live animals, birds and insects; (b) the constructing, repairing, decorating, or improving of 28 29 new or existing buildings or other structures under, upon, or above 30 real property of or for consumers, including the installing or 31 attaching of any article of tangible personal property therein or thereto, whether or not such personal property becomes a part of the 32 realty by virtue of installation, and shall also include the sale of 33 34 services or charges made for the clearing of land and the moving of 35 earth excepting the mere leveling of land used in commercial farming or agriculture; (c) the charge for labor and services rendered in respect 36 37 to constructing, repairing, or improving any structure upon, above, or under any real property owned by an owner who conveys the property by 38 39 title, possession, or any other means to the person performing such

construction, repair, or improvement for the purpose of performing such 1 2 construction, repair, or improvement and the property is then reconveyed by title, possession, or any other means to the original 3 4 owner; (d) the sale of or charge made for labor and services rendered in respect to the cleaning, fumigating, razing or moving of existing 5 buildings or structures, but shall not include the charge made for 6 7 janitorial services; and for purposes of this section the term 8 "janitorial services" shall mean those cleaning and caretaking services 9 ordinarily performed by commercial janitor service businesses 10 including, but not limited to, wall and window washing, floor cleaning and waxing, and the cleaning in place of rugs, drapes and upholstery. 11 The term "janitorial services" does not include painting, papering, 12 13 furnace or septic tank cleaning, snow removal repairing, or 14 sandblasting; (e) the sale of or charge made for labor and services 15 rendered in respect to automobile towing and similar automotive 16 transportation services, but not in respect to those required to report 17 and pay taxes under chapter 82.16 RCW; (f) the sale of and charge made for the furnishing of lodging and all other services by a hotel, 18 19 rooming house, tourist court, motel, trailer camp, and the granting of 20 any similar license to use real property, as distinguished from the renting or leasing of real property, and it shall be presumed that the 21 22 occupancy of real property for a continuous period of one month or more 23 constitutes a rental or lease of real property and not a mere license 24 to use or enjoy the same; (g) the sale of or charge made for tangible 25 personal property, labor and services to persons taxable under (a), 26 (b), (c), (d), (e), and (f) above when such sales or charges are for 27 property, labor and services which are used or consumed in whole or in part by such persons in the performance of any activity defined as a 28 29 "sale at retail" or "retail sale" even though such property, labor and 30 services may be resold after such use or consumption. Nothing 31 contained in this paragraph shall be construed to modify the first paragraph of this section and nothing contained in the first paragraph 32 33 of this section shall be construed to modify this paragraph.

(3) The term "sale at retail" or "retail sale" shall include the sale of or charge made for personal business or professional services including amounts designated as interest, rents, fees, admission, and other service emoluments however designated, received by persons engaging in the following business activities: (a) Amusement and recreation businesses including but not limited to golf, pool,

billiards, skating, bowling, ski lifts and tows and others; (b)
 abstract, title insurance and escrow businesses; (c) credit bureau
 businesses; (d) automobile parking and storage garage businesses.

4 (4) The term shall also include the renting or leasing of tangible5 personal property to consumers.

6 (5) The term shall also include the providing of telephone service, 7 as defined in RCW 82.04.065, to consumers.

8 (6) The term shall not include the sale of or charge made for labor 9 and services rendered in respect to the building, repairing, or 10 improving of any street, place, road, highway, easement, right of way, mass public transportation terminal or parking facility, bridge, 11 tunnel, or trestle which is owned by a municipal corporation or 12 13 political subdivision of the state or by the United States and which is used or to be used primarily for foot or vehicular traffic including 14 15 mass transportation vehicles of any kind. ((The term shall also not 16 include sales of feed, seed, seedlings, fertilizer, and spray materials 17 to persons who participate in the federal conservation reserve program or its successor administered by the United States department of 18 19 agriculture, or to persons for the purpose of producing for sale any agricultural product whatsoever, including plantation Christmas trees 20 and milk, eggs, wool, fur, meat, honey, or other substances obtained 21 22 from animals, birds, or insects but only when such production and 23 subsequent sale are exempt from tax under RCW 82.04.330, nor shall it 24 include sales of chemical sprays or washes to persons for the purpose 25 of post-harvest treatment of fruit for the prevention of scald, fungus, 26 mold, or decay.))

27 (7) The term shall not include the sale of or charge made for labor 28 and services rendered in respect to the constructing, repairing, 29 decorating, or improving of new or existing buildings or other 30 structures under, upon, or above real property of or for the United 31 States, any instrumentality thereof, or a county or city housing authority created pursuant to chapter 35.82 RCW, including the 32 installing, or attaching of any article of tangible personal property 33 34 therein or thereto, whether or not such personal property becomes a 35 part of the realty by virtue of installation. Nor shall the term include the sale of services or charges made for the clearing of land 36 37 and the moving of earth of or for the United States, any 38 instrumentality thereof, or a county or city housing authority.

1 sec. 5. RCW 82.04.330 and 1988 c 253 s 2 are each amended to read
2 as follows:

3 This chapter shall not apply to any ((person in respect to the 4 business of growing or producing for sale upon the person's own lands 5 or upon land in which the person has a present right of possession, any agricultural or horticultural produce or crop, or of raising upon the 6 7 person's own lands or upon land in which the person has a present right 8 of possession, any plantation Christmas tree or any animal, bird, fish, or insect, or the milk, eggs, wool, fur, meat, honey, or other 9 substance obtained therefrom, or in respect to the sale of such 10 products)) farmer that sells any agricultural product at wholesale ((by 11 such grower, producer, or raiser thereof)). This exemption shall not 12 apply to any person selling such products at retail ((or using such 13 products as ingredients in a manufacturing process; nor to the sale of 14 15 any animal or substance obtained therefrom by a person in connection with the person's business of operating a stockyard or a slaughter or 16 17 packing house; nor to any person in respect to the business of taking, cultivating, or raising timber; nor to any association of persons 18 19 whatever, whether mutual, cooperative or otherwise, engaging in any 20 business activity with respect to which tax liability is imposed under the provisions of this chapter. As used in this section, "fish" means 21 22 fish which are cultivated or raised entirely within confined rearing areas on the person's own land or on land in which the person has a 23 24 present right of possession)).

This chapter shall also not apply to any persons who participate in the federal conservation reserve program or its successor administered by the United States department of agriculture with respect to land enrolled in that program.

29 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 6. This act is necessary for the immediate 30 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the 31 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take 32 effect immediately."

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
