- 6 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 50.22 RCW 7 to read as follows:
- Supplemental additional benefits shall be available to individuals who, under this chapter, had a balance of extended benefits available
- 10 after payments up to and including the week ending February 26, 1994.
- 11 (1) Total supplemental additional benefits payable shall be equal
- 12 to the extended benefit balance remaining after extended benefit
- 13 payments for up to and including the week ending February 26, 1994, and
- 14 shall be paid at the same weekly benefit amount.
- 15 (2) The week ending March 5, 1994, is the first week for which 16 supplemental additional benefits are payable.
- 17 (3) Supplemental additional benefits shall be paid under the same 18 terms and conditions as extended benefits.
- 19 (4) Supplemental additional benefits are not payable for weeks more 20 than one year beyond the end of the benefit year of the regular claim.
- (5) Weeks of supplemental additional benefits may not be paid for weeks that begin after the start of a new extended benefit period, or any totally federally funded benefit program with eligibility criteria
- 24 and benefits comparable to additional benefits.
- 25 (6) Weeks of supplemental additional benefits may not be paid for 26 weeks of unemployment beginning after December 31, 1995.
- 27 (7) The department shall seek federal funding to reimburse the 28 state for the supplemental additional benefits paid under this section.
- 29 Any federal funds received by the state for reimbursement shall be
- 30 deposited in the unemployment trust fund solely for the payment of
- 31 benefits under this title."
- Renumber the remaining sections consecutively and correct any internal references accordingly.
- 34 On page 3, after line 4, insert the following:
- 35 "(3) Section 3 of this act is necessary for the immediate
- 36 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the

- 1 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take
