7 On page 63, after line 24 of the amendment, insert:

8 "(21) \$40,000 of the general fund-state appropriation is  
9 provided solely to implement sections 132 through 135 of Engrossed  
10 Second Substitute House Bill No. 2319 (violence prevention). If  
11 sections 132 through 135 of Engrossed Second Substitute House Bill  
12 No. 2319 are not enacted by June 30, 1994, the appropriation in  
13 this subsection shall lapse."

14 On page 88, line 7 of the amendment, strike "36,333,000" and  
15 insert "36,308,000"

16 On page 88, line 14 of the amendment, strike "72,974,000" and  
17 insert "72,949,000"

18 On page 89, line 8 of the amendment, strike "100,000" and  
19 insert "~~((100,000))~~ 75,000"

**EFFECT:** Increases the appropriation to the Department of Health to develop a plan for a state-wide suicide prevention program addressing youth suicide. Reduces funding to the Superintendent of Public Instruction used for developing guidelines for youth suicide prevention. Increases the general fund-state appropriation by net \$15,000.
