(vii) Biennial cost of acquiring and maintaining each type
of water resource data used by the agency.
For the purposes of this section, a "natural resource
management agency" includes any of the following state agencies:
department of ecology, department of natural resources,
department of fish and wildlife, department of health.
The report shall be presented to the legislature on or
before December 1. 1994."
Renumber the remaining sections consecutively and correct

any internal references accordingly.

EFFECT: Instructs the water rights programs review task force to conduct a study comparing the effects of consolidating all state natural resource agency water resource data management activities with the current system of agency water resource data independence. Lists seven categories of data to be collected. State natural resource agencies include ecology, natural resources, fish and wildlife, and health. Instructs that the report be presented to the legislature on or before December 1, 1994.
