5 On page 2, after line 7, insert the following:

6 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** It is the purpose of sections 3 and 4 of
7 this act to give authority to the office of archaeology and historic
8 preservation to identify, record, and evaluate all state-owned
9 facilities to determine which of these facilities may be considered
10 historically significant, to require the office to provide copies of
11 the inventory to departments, agencies, and institutions that have
12 jurisdiction over the buildings and sites listed, and to authorize the
13 office of archaeology and historic preservation to convene a task force
14 of state agencies to develop guidelines for state agencies to identify,
15 evaluate, and protect historic properties.

16 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** Unless the context clearly requires
17 otherwise, the following definitions apply throughout section 4 of this
18 act.

19 (1) "Agency" means the state agency, department, or institution
20 that has ownership of historic property.

21 (2) "Historic properties" means those buildings, sites, objects,
22 structures, and districts that are listed in or eligible for listing in
23 the National Register of Historic Places.

24 (3) "Office" means the office of archaeology and historic
25 preservation within the department of community development.

26 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 4.** (1) By January 2, 1994, the office shall
27 provide each agency with a list of the agency's properties currently
28 listed on the National Register of Historic Places. By January 2,
29 1995, agencies that own property shall provide to the office a list of
30 those properties that are either at least fifty years old or that may
31 be eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places.
32 If funding is available, the office may provide grants to state
33 agencies to assist in the development of the agency's list. By June

1 30, 1995, the office shall compile and disseminate an inventory of
2 state-owned historic properties.

3 (2) The office shall provide technical historic preservation
4 training for agency staff involved with the identification and
5 management of historic properties.

6 NEW SECTION. Sec. 5. (1) The office shall convene a task force to
7 develop recommendations on establishing state agency historic
8 preservation guidelines to identify, evaluate, and protect historic
9 properties. The task force may include but not be limited to
10 representatives of affected state agencies and other interested or
11 affected parties. Topics the task force shall address include the
12 following:

13 (a) Recommendations on long-range management strategies for the
14 protection of state-owned historic properties; and

15 (b) Development of a process to review and comment on state agency
16 actions that might affect identified historic properties.

17 (2) The task force shall present its recommendations to the
18 governor and the legislature no later than October 31, 1995.

19 NEW SECTION. Sec. 6. Sections 3 and 4 of this act are each added
20 to chapter 27.34 RCW."
