5 On page 2, after line 24, insert the following:

6 "Sec. 4. RCW 70.95.060 and 1969 ex.s. c 134 s 6 are each amended
7 to read as follows:

8 (1) The department in accordance with procedures prescribed by the
9 Administrative Procedure Act, chapter 34.05 RCW, as now or hereafter
10 amended, may adopt such minimum functional standards for solid waste
11 handling as it deems appropriate. The department in adopting such
12 standards may classify areas of the state with respect to population
13 density, climate, geology, and other relevant factors bearing on solid
14 waste disposal standards.

15 (2) Standards with an effective date on or after October 1, 1993
16 shall define "existing municipal solid waste landfill units" to include
17 defined areas of land that have been permitted by a jurisdictional
18 health department to receive, and any part of which is receiving, solid
19 waste as of the effective date of the standard. This subsection (2)
20 shall apply only to landfills with a total capacity of less than two
21 million tons of municipal solid waste as of the effective date of the
22 standard. This subsection shall apply only to landfills in counties
23 bordering the state of Oregon that have a total capacity of less than
24 two million tons of municipal solid waste as of October 1, 1993.
25 Furthermore, for such landfills, this subsection shall apply only as
26 long as the landfill does not receive waste from other counties, except
27 as provided under a contract for disposal of waste entered before
28 October 1, 1993, and any renewals of such contract."
