- 8 in the face of these challenges, the teaching profession has kept the
- 9 state's test scores above the national average.
- The legislature also finds that although educators are asked to do
- 11 steadily more than teach, educators have not received additional
- 12 compensation accordingly. Rather, salaries in Washington, as compared
- 13 to other states, have fallen from eighth in 1983 to seventeenth in

- The legislature believes that educators deserve additional
