4 RULED BEYOND SCOPE AND OBJECT 3/4/94

5 On page 2, after line 8, insert the following:

6 "Sec. 2. RCW 70.05.060 and 1991 c 3 s 308 are each amended to read
7 as follows:

8 (1) Each local board of health shall have supervision over all
9 matters pertaining to the preservation of the life and health of the
10 people within its jurisdiction and shall:

11 ((+1)) (a) Enforce through the local health officer or the
12 administrative officer appointed under RCW 70.05.040, if any, the
13 public health statutes of the state and rules promulgated by the state
14 board of health and the secretary of health;

15 ((+2)) (b) Supervise the maintenance of all health and sanitary
16 measures for the protection of the public health within its
17 jurisdiction;

18 ((+3)) (c) Enact such local rules and regulations as are necessary
19 in order to preserve, promote and improve the public health and provide
20 for the enforcement thereof;

21 ((+4)) (d) Provide for the control and prevention of any
22 dangerous, contagious or infectious disease within the jurisdiction of
23 the local health department;

24 ((+5)) (e) Provide for the prevention, control and abatement of
25 nuisances detrimental to the public health;

26 ((+6)) (f) Make such reports to the state board of health through
27 the local health officer or the administrative officer as the state
28 board of health may require; ((and

29 +7)) (g) Establish fee schedules for issuing or renewing licenses
30 or permits or for such other services as are authorized by the law and
31 the rules of the state board of health: PROVIDED, That such fees for
32 services shall not exceed the actual cost of providing any such
33 services; and

34 (h) Adopt rules regulating the design, construction, installation,
35 and maintenance of "systems of sewerage" as defined in RCW 36.94.010.
36 Such rules shall be submitted to the appropriate state agencies for

1 approval pursuant to RCW 36.94.100 and shall conform to standards
2 established by the department of health except that:

3 (i) The local rules may vary from the state standards when the
4 local board has determined that the variance will not pose any hazard
5 to the public health; and

6 (ii) The department of health may require the local board to adopt
7 a repair and maintenance standard to ensure on-site sanitary systems
8 meet the requirements for a safe, functioning system.

9 (2) The department of health, upon giving its approval to the local
10 board of health on-site sanitary system rules, shall grant the county
11 authority to, by adoption of its rules, system of sewerage plan or
12 amendments, approve and issue a permit for the installation of an on-
13 site sanitary system that varies from the state standards for on-site
14 sanitary systems without obtaining a waiver from the department of
15 health."
