9 (1) The ~~((council))~~ governor's advisory committee on international
10 trade is established. The ~~((council))~~ advisory committee shall consist
11 of ~~((fifteen))~~ eighteen members as follows:

12 (a) Two members of trade organizations, appointed by the governor;

13 (b) Two representatives of ports, appointed by the governor;

14 (c) Two representatives of businesses active in exporting goods,
15 appointed by the governor;

16 ~~((Three representatives from the executive legislative
17 committee on economic development created in chapter . . . (Senate Bill
18 No. 5300), Laws of 1993))~~ Four legislative members, two from the house
19 of representatives, one from each caucus, appointed by the speaker of
20 the house of representatives; and two from the senate, one from each
21 caucus, appointed by the president of the senate;

22 (e) Two members with experience in foreign marketing, appointed by
23 the governor;

24 (f) Two experts in financing export transactions, appointed by the
25 governor;

26 (g) Two representatives of labor, one of whom shall represent
27 longshore workers;

28 (h)(i) The Washington state trade representative, if the position
29 is created by statute or gubernatorial appointment, to serve as chair
30 of the advisory committee, or (ii) the director of the department of
31 community, trade, and economic development or the director's designee,
32 to serve as chair of the advisory committee, if the position of
33 Washington state trade representative does not exist; and

34 ~~((h))~~ (i) The director of the department of agriculture or the
35 director's designee.

1 (2) Nonlegislative members may receive reimbursement from the
2 governor's office for travel under RCW 43.03.050 and 43.03.060.
3 Legislative members may be reimbursed under RCW 41.04.300.

4 (3) The ~~((council))~~ advisory committee shall:

5 (a) Advise the ~~((executive-legislative-committee-on-economic
6 development))~~ governor and legislature regarding policies, programs,
7 and activities to enhance the exporting of Washington goods and
8 services to international markets;

9 (b) Review current state export targeting efforts and advise the
10 ~~((executive-legislative-committee-on-economic-development))~~ governor
11 and legislature regarding markets with potential that currently are not
12 being emphasized;

13 (c) Assist in the coordination of public export programs state-
14 wide;

15 (d) Identify for the ~~((executive-legislative-committee-on-economic
16 development))~~ governor and legislature current and long-term
17 international trade issues that need to be addressed by the state in
18 its long-term economic development plan;

19 (e) Recommend methods to increase the awareness of international
20 trade, especially its opportunities and its importance, throughout the
21 state;

22 (f) Study the impact of the Uruguay round of the general agreement
23 on tariffs and trade and the North American free trade agreement on the
24 state's small manufacturing and export firms, focusing on the
25 competitive threats and opportunities presented by the trade agreements
26 to the state's six most significant traded sectors as measured by the
27 number of employees in the sector and the aggregate dollar volume of
28 goods and services traded in the sector. The counsel shall identify
29 and utilize existing analyses, studies, and data from the federal
30 government, national and state business and labor organizations, and
31 educational and policy institutes."
