23 (((2))) <u>(3)</u> Where <u>known or</u> available, the information provided 24 shall include:

(a) A review of the birth family's and the child's previous medical history, ((if available,)) including the child's x-rays, examinations, hospitalizations, and immunizations. After July 1, 1992, medical histories shall be given on a standardized reporting form developed by the department;

30 (b) A physical exam of the child by a licensed physician with31 appropriate laboratory tests and x-rays;

32 (c) A referral to a specialist if indicated; and

(d) A written copy of the evaluation with recommendations to theadoptive family receiving the report.

information concerning the child's mental, physical, and sensory handicaps. The entities or persons providing the information have no duty, beyond providing the information, to explain or interpret the records or information regarding the child's present or future health.

7 (1) Every person, firm, society, association, ((or)) corporation, or state agency receiving, securing a home for, or otherwise caring for 8 9 a minor child shall transmit to the prospective adopting parent prior to placement and shall make available to all persons with whom a child 10 has been placed by adoption, a family background and child and family 11 12 social history report, which includes a chronological history of the circumstances surrounding the adoptive placement and any available 13 14 psychiatric reports, psychological reports, court reports pertaining to dependency or custody, or school reports. Such reports or information 15 shall not reveal the identity of the birth parents of the child but 16 shall contain reasonably available nonidentifying information. 17

18 (2) Entities and persons obligated to provide information under 19 this section shall make reasonable efforts to locate records and 20 information concerning the child's family background and social 21 history. The entities or persons providing the information have no 22 duty, beyond providing the information, to explain or interpret the 23 records or information regarding the child's mental or physical health.

24 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 26.33 RCW 25 to read as follows:

The department shall adopt rules, in consultation with affected parties, establishing minimum standards for making reasonable efforts to locate records and information relating to adoptions as required under RCW 26.33.350 and 26.33.380."
