15 (2) Know and apply the basic elements and principles of English,
16 mathematics, science, history, geography, government, foreign
17 languages, arts, health, and fitness;

18 (3) Be able to think critically and creatively using the knowledge
19 and skills gained from goals one and two from subsections (1) and (2)
20 of this section to form reasoned judgments, solve problems, and resolve
21 conflicts;

22 (4) Appreciate their own worth and importance and have the
23 character to be accountable for themselves and to act responsibly
24 toward others. This goal is the primary responsibility of families but
25 can be assisted by schools, work groups, and communities.

26 It is the intent of the legislature that all students should
27 demonstrate acquisition of these goals when they graduate from the
28 public schools through an assessment system that is valid and reliable
29 and has the confidence of the communities served."

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
