6 added to chapter 74.14A RCW to read as follows:

7 (1) A children's services commission is created. The commission  
8 shall be composed of fourteen members, to be appointed by the governor.  
9 The membership of the commission shall include: The secretary of the  
10 department of social and health services, who shall chair the  
11 commission; a citizen; a youth; a consumer of social services; a  
12 representative of the department of health, the department of community  
13 development, and the office of the superintendent of public  
14 instruction; and one representative of a county, a city, a town, a  
15 federally recognized Indian tribe, a school district, an existing  
16 children's commission, and a private agency provider of children's  
17 services. The governor shall ensure the racial, ethnic, and geographic  
18 diversity in the commission's membership.

19 (2) The commission shall:

20 (a) Develop a proposal for the creation of regional councils whose  
21 primary purpose shall be the local coordination and administration of  
22 an integrated program of community support for children, youth, and  
23 family services;

24 (b) Develop recommendations regarding who should be represented on  
25 the membership of the regional councils;

26 (c) Develop recommendations regarding the number of regional  
27 councils that should be created and include the specific boundaries for  
28 the proposed regional councils;

29 (d) Identify programs and funds, which are currently appropriated  
30 to the department of social and health services, the department of  
31 health, the department of community development, and the office of the  
32 superintendent of public instruction, which should be transferred to  
33 the regional councils on a block grant basis;

34 (e) Develop a list of all state and federally funded prevention and  
35 early intervention programs for children, youth, and families,  
36 including a description and current budget for each program;

1 (f) Determine the information indicated in section 1002(4) of this  
2 act as necessary for the development of programs designed to assist  
3 children in school achievement;

4 (g) Review any other related matters as determined by the chair of  
5 the commission.

6 (3)(a) The commission shall submit a preliminary report to the  
7 legislature by January 1, 1994, containing: (i) Recommendations on the  
8 number of regional councils that should be created, the proposed  
9 membership of the councils, and the specific boundaries for the  
10 proposed regional councils; and (ii) a list of all state and federally  
11 funded prevention and early intervention programs for children, youth,  
12 and families, including a description and current budget for each  
13 program.

14 (b) The commission shall submit a final report containing all of  
15 its recommendations to the senate health and human services committee  
16 and the house of representatives human services committee by January 1,  
17 1995.

18 (4) Members of the commission shall be reimbursed for travel  
19 expenses in the performance of their duties in accordance with RCW  
20 43.03.050 and 43.03.060.
