4 On page 8, line 22, beginning with "This" strike everything down to
5 and including the period on line 27, and insert the following:

6 "For hydraulic projects approved between January 1, 1989, and the
7 effect date of this act for which a maintenance plan has not been
8 submitted, the applicant may contact the department of fisheries or the
9 department of wildlife to determine whether the conditions of the
10 original permit are adequate for maintenance work. If the conditions
11 of the original permit are adequate, the department shall issue a
12 permit within fifteen days. If the original conditions are not
13 adequate the applicant may submit a maintenance plan for review by the
14 department. If either the department of fisheries or the department of
15 wildlife denies approval of a maintenance plan, that department shall
16 provide in writing a statement of the specific reasons how the
17 maintenance plan adversely affects fish life and what changes would be
18 necessary to adequately protect fish life and gain approval of the
19 maintenance plan. Maintenance plans approved under this section may be
20 approved for a period of five years and may be renewed upon request.
21 After the effective date of this act, an applicant may apply for a
22 hydraulic approval and a five-year maintenance plan simultaneously."
