- 18 sixteen may not be employed more than forty hours per week.
- 19 (3) A minor may not be employed more than eight hours per day nor
- 20 more than six days in any one week. Minors employed past eight p.m. in

- 22 required to be on the premises. During the school year, a minor may
- 23 not be employed for more than forty hours per week.
- 24 (4) A minor may not be employed on consecutive nights, both of

- 27 period of at least thirty minutes.
- 28 (6) A minor employee shall be given a rest period of at least ten
