26 "Sec. 5. RCW 46.70.061 and 1990 c 250 s 65 are each amended to
27 read as follows:

28 (1) The annual fees for original licenses issued for twelve
29 consecutive months from the date of issuance under this chapter shall
30 be:

31 (a) Vehicle dealers, principal place of business for each and
32 every license classification: Five hundred dollars;

1 (b) Vehicle dealers, each subagency: fifty dollars;

2 temporary subagency: twenty-five dollars;

3 (c) Vehicle manufacturers: Five hundred dollars.

4 (2) The annual fee for renewal of any license issued pursuant to
5 this chapter shall be:

6 (a) Vehicle dealers, principal place of business for each and
7 every license classification: Two hundred fifty dollars;

8 (b) Vehicle dealers, each and every subagent: Twenty-five
9 dollars;

10 (c) Vehicle manufacturers: Two hundred fifty dollars.

11 If any licensee fails or neglects to apply for such renewal within
12 thirty days after the expiration of the license, or assigned renewal
13 date under a staggered licensing system, the license shall be declared
14 canceled by the director, in which case the licensee will be required
15 to apply for an original license and pay the fee required for the
16 original license.

17 (3) The fee for the transfer to another location of any license
18 classification issued pursuant to this chapter shall be twenty-five
19 dollars.

20 (4) The fee for original vehicle dealer license plates shall be
21 thirty-one dollars and thirty-five cents and manufacturer license
22 plates shall be ~~((the amount required by law for vehicle license plats,~~
23 ~~exclusive of excise tax, except those specified in RCW 82.44.030, and~~
24 ~~gross weight and tonnage fees))~~ thirty-two dollars and eighty-five
25 cents. The fee for renewal vehicle dealer license plates and
26 manufacturer license plates shall be twenty-five dollars and eighty
27 five cents.

28 (5) All fees collected under this chapter shall be deposited in
29 the state treasury and credited to the motor vehicle fund.

30 (6) The fees prescribed in this section are in addition to any
31 excise taxes imposed by chapter 82.44 RCW.

32 Renumber the sections consecutively and correct any internal
33 references accordingly.
