7 "WHEREAS, Legislative action in recent years establishing the Work  
8 Force Training and Education Coordinating Board was an integral step in  
9 developing a strategic approach to work force development in  
10 Washington; and

11 WHEREAS, The work force training and education coordinating board  
12 is developing the state's first comprehensive plan for work force  
13 training; and

14 WHEREAS, A recent report of the 1993 Joint Legislative Task Force  
15 on Unemployment Insurance highlighted the need for greater coordination  
16 between the existing sixty-three training and education and related  
17 programs contained in thirteen agencies within state government; and

18 WHEREAS, The federal government has initiated a major policy  
19 initiative within the United States Department of Labor to better serve  
20 the training and retraining needs of the unemployed within the United  
21 States; and

22 WHEREAS, The legislature seeks to address the challenges and  
23 opportunities outlined by the Joint Legislative Task Force's report and  
24 assist the Work Force Training and Education Coordinating Board; and

25 WHEREAS, The sixty-three work force training and education and  
26 related programs and the Work Force Training and Education Coordinating  
27 Board's comprehensive plan span the interests of at least eight policy  
28 committees of the Senate and the House of Representatives;

29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Senate of the state of  
30 Washington, the House of Representatives concurring, That the Joint  
31 Legislative Oversight Committee on Training and Retraining be  
32 established; and

33 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That there be eight committee members  
34 chosen as follows: Four members of the Senate, two from each of the  
35 two largest caucuses appointed by the President of the Senate; and four  
36 members of the House of Representatives, two from each of the two

1 largest caucuses appointed by the Speaker of the House of  
2 Representatives; and

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the committee select a chair from  
4 among its own members; and

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Senate and the House of  
6 Representatives provide staffing to the Joint Legislative Oversight  
7 Committee on Training and Retraining; and

8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That nonlegislative members be reimbursed  
9 for travel in accordance with RCW 43.03.050 and 43.03.060 and that  
10 legislative members be reimbursed for travel in accordance with RCW  
11 44.04.120; and

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the committee receive and review the  
13 Work Force Training and Education Coordinating Board's comprehensive  
14 plan for work force training and education including recommendations to  
15 improve the state's work force training and education system. The  
16 recommendations shall include, but not be limited to, recommendations  
17 for improving the coordination, services, and accountability of the  
18 state's work force training and education system; and

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the committee report to the  
20 legislature with recommendations on work force training and retraining  
21 by January 31, 1995."
