- AN ACT Relating to nonpartisan sheriffs; amending RCW 29.18.010,
- 2 29.21.010, 29.21.015, and 29.21.070; and providing an effective date.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 29.18.010 and 1990 c 59 s 78 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 Candidates for the following offices shall be nominated at partisan 7 primaries held pursuant to the provisions of this chapter:
- 8 (1) Congressional offices;
- 9 (2) All state offices except (a) judicial offices and (b) the 10 office of superintendent of public instruction;
- 11 (3) All county offices except (a) judicial offices, (b) sheriff,
- 12 except in a county for which the position is declared to be a partisan
- 13 office by the county's home rule charter, and ((\(\frac{b}{c}\))) (c) those offices
- 14 where a county home rule charter provides otherwise.
- 15 **Sec. 2.** RCW 29.21.010 and 1990 c 59 s 89 are each amended to read
- 16 as follows:
- 17 All city and town primaries shall be nonpartisan. Primaries for
- 18 special purpose districts, except those districts that require

- 1 ownership of property within the district as a prerequisite to voting,
- 2 shall be nonpartisan. Primaries for the office of county sheriff shall
- 3 be nonpartisan except in a county for which the position is declared
- 4 to be a partisan office by the county's home rule charter. City, town,
- 5 county sheriff, and district primaries shall be held as provided in RCW
- 6 29.13.070.
- 7 The purpose of this section is to establish the holding of a
- 8 primary, subject to the exemptions in RCW 29.21.015, as a uniform
- 9 procedural requirement to the holding of city, town, county sheriff,
- 10 and district elections. These provisions supersede any and all other
- 11 statutes, whether general or special in nature, having different
- 12 election requirements.
- 13 **Sec. 3.** RCW 29.21.015 and 1990 c 59 s 90 are each amended to read
- 14 as follows:
- No primary may be held for any single position in any city, town,
- 16 or district or for the nonpartisan position of county sheriff, as
- 17 required by RCW 29.21.010, if, after the last day allowed for
- 18 candidates to withdraw, there are no more than two candidates filed for
- 19 the position. The county auditor shall, as soon as possible, notify
- 20 all the candidates so affected that the office for which they filed
- 21 will not appear on the primary ballot. Names of candidates so notified
- 22 shall be printed upon the general election ballot in the manner
- 23 specified by RCW 29.30.025.
- 24 Sec. 4. RCW 29.21.070 and 1990 c 59 s 91 are each amended to read
- 25 as follows:
- The offices of superintendent of public instruction, justice of the
- 27 supreme court, judge of the court of appeals, judge of the superior
- 28 court, and judge of the district court shall be nonpartisan and the
- 29 candidates therefor shall be nominated and elected as such. Except in
- 30 a county for which the position of sheriff is declared to be a partisan
- 31 office by the county's home rule charter, the office of county sheriff
- 32 shall be nonpartisan and the candidates therefor shall be nominated and
- 33 <u>elected as such.</u>
- 34 All city, town, and special purpose district elective offices shall
- 35 be nonpartisan and the candidates therefor shall be nominated and

36 elected as such.
