- 2 and adding a new section to chapter 59.20 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 59.20 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 A tenant in a mobile home park may share his or her mobile home
- with any person over eighteen years of age, if that person is providing
- live-in home health care or live-in hospice care to the tenant under an 8
- approved plan of treatment ordered by the tenant's physician. 10 live-in care provider is not considered a tenant of the park and shall
- have no rights of tenancy in the park. 11 Any agreement between the

tenant and the live-in care provider does not change the terms and

- 13 conditions of the rental agreement between the landlord and the tenant.
- 14 The live-in care provider shall comply with the rules of the mobile
- 15 home park, the rental agreement, and this chapter. The landlord may
