- 1 AN ACT Relating to solid waste received from outside the state;
- 2 adding a new section to chapter 70.95 RCW; and declaring an emergency.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 70.95 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) At least sixty days prior to receiving solid waste generated from outside of the state, a landfill or incineration permit holder or applicant shall report to the department the types and quantities of 8 waste to be received from an out-of-state source. The department shall 9 10 develop guidelines for reporting this information. The guidelines shall provide for less than sixty days' notice for shipments of waste 11 12 made on a short-term or emergency basis. The requirements of this 13 subsection shall take effect upon completion of the guidelines.
 - (2) Upon notice under subsection (1) of this section, the department shall identify all activities and costs necessary to ensure that solid waste generated out-of-state meets standards equivalent to those required of solid waste generated within the state. The department may assess a fee on the out-of-state waste sufficient to recover the actual costs incurred in ensuring that the out-of-state

- 1 waste meets equivalent state standards. The department may delegate,
- 2 to a local health department, authority to implement the activities
- 3 identified by the department under this subsection. All money received
- 4 from fees imposed under this subsection shall be deposited into the
- 5 solid waste management account created by RCW 70.95.800.
- 6 (3) The department shall prohibit in-state land disposal and
- 7 incineration of solid waste generated from outside of the state, unless
- 8 the waste meets: (a) Waste reduction and recycling requirements
- 9 equivalent to those required under chapter 70.95 RCW; and (b)
- 10 procurement requirements equivalent to those required under chapter
- 11 43.19A RCW.
- 12 (4) Subsections (2) and (3) of this section shall not apply to
- 13 contracts entered into on or before July 1, 1993.
- 14 (5) The department may adopt rules to implement this section.
- 15 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** If any provision of this act or its
- 16 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the
- 17 remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other
- 18 persons or circumstances is not affected.
- 19 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** This act is necessary for the immediate
- 20 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
- 21 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take
- 22 effect immediately.
