- 8 lawfully required of him or her by a public servant, or (2) in any such
- 9 statement or report shall make any knowingly untrue statement to a
- 10 public servant, or (3) shall knowingly hinder, delay, or obstruct any
- 11 public servant in the discharge of ((his)) official powers or duties;
- 12 shall be guilty of a gross misdemeanor.
