- 1 AN ACT Relating to contracts for admission to nursing homes; and
- 2 adding new sections to chapter 18.51 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 18.51 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- to read as follows:

  (1) A nursing home that requires payment of a deposit or minimum
- 7 stay fee, by or on behalf of persons seeking admission to the nursing
- 8 home, shall refund a portion of the deposit or fee if the person on
- 9 whose behalf the deposit or minimum stay fee was paid does not reside
- 10 in the nursing home for the number of days that the deposit or fee
- 11 would pay for at the daily rate charged by the nursing home for the
- 12 care of the person. The amount of the refund shall be equal to the
- 13 amount of the deposit or minimum stay fee remaining after deducting an
- 14 amount equal to the number of days the person resided in the facility
- 15 multiplied by the daily rate charged by the nursing home for the care
- 16 of the person.
- 17 (2) Where a nursing home requires the execution of an admission
- 18 contract by or on behalf of an individual seeking admission to the

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- 1 facility, the terms of the contract shall be consistent with the
- 2 requirements of this section.

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- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 18.51 RCW to read as follows:
- The failure of a nursing home to refund a portion of a deposit or minimum stay fee, or to include an admission contract term as required by section 1 of this act, is a matter affecting the public interest for the purpose of applying chapter 19.86 RCW and is not reasonable in relation to the development or preservation of business. A violation of section 1 of this act constitutes an unfair or deceptive act or practice in trade or commerce for the purpose of applying chapter 19.86

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
