- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 70.93 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) By January 1, 1994, each county or city with a transfer station
- 7 or landfill in its jurisdiction shall adopt an ordinance to reduce
- litter from vehicles. The ordinance shall require the operator of a 8
- vehicle transporting solid waste to a transfer station or landfill to
- 10 secure or cover the vehicle's waste in a manner that will prevent
- The ordinance may provide exemptions for vehicle operators 11
- transporting waste that is unlikely to spill from a vehicle. 12
- 13 (2) At a minimum, the ordinance shall require the following fees,
- 14 in addition to other landfill charges, for a person arriving at a
- 15 landfill or transfer station without a cover on the vehicle's waste:
- (a) Three dollars for loads of 0.1 to 3 cubic yards; 16
- 17 (b) Five dollars for loads of 3.1 to 10 cubic yards;
- (c) Ten dollars for loads over 10 cubic yards. 18

- 1 (3) The fee collected under subsection (2) of this section shall be 2 deposited with the city or county in which the landfill or transfer 3 station is located.
- 4 (4) A vehicle transporting sand, dirt, or gravel in compliance with 5 the provisions of RCW 46.61.655 shall not be required to secure or 6 cover a load pursuant to ordinances adopted under this section.
