- 1 AN ACT Relating to the health of child motor vehicle passengers
- 2 exposed to secondhand smoke; adding a new section to chapter 46.61 RCW;
- 3 and prescribing penalties.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 46.61 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (1) No person may smoke any kind of lighted pipe, cigar, cigarette,
- 8 or any other lighted smoking equipment within a motor vehicle if the
- 9 motor vehicle contains any passengers under the age of sixteen years.
- 10 (2) A person violating this section shall be issued a notice of
- 11 traffic infraction under chapter 46.63 RCW. A finding that a person
- 12 has committed a traffic infraction under this section shall be
- 13 contained in the driver's abstract but shall not be available to
- 14 insurance companies or employers.
- 15 (3) Failure to comply with the requirements of this section does
- 16 not constitute negligence per se.
- 17 (4) Enforcement of this section by law enforcement officers may be
- 18 accomplished only as a secondary action when a driver of a motor
